

Lifecycle of a Semester

Important Dates & Deadlines

1- Enrollment appointments are assigned in myWSU

Each student is assigned an enrollment window in myWSU during which they can register for the upcoming semester. Advising holds are placed by the registrar.

2- Advising

Advising opens! New students can schedule their advising appointment after completing orientation. Continuing students should schedule their advising appointment before their enrollment window opens. Academic advisors will lift student's holds during or after their appointments.

3- Registering

The enrollment windows start to open, and students register for courses.

4- First day of classes & tuition due

The first day of the semester is also when tuition is due.

5- Dropping

The drop deadline for 16-week course is typically the third or fourth week of class. The drop deadline for seven-week classes is typically much earlier, on the third day of the first week. 6- Tenth Day

Students must finalize their enrollment for that semester as the financial aid department looks at enrollment levels and determines funding amounts.

7- Withdrawing

The last day to withdraw from the semester typically falls a few days before final begins. This is the last chance to receive W's for all classes. There is no tuition reimbursement at this point in the semester.

8- Checking Grades

Final grades are typically available about a week after finals and are posted in myWSU for students to access.
